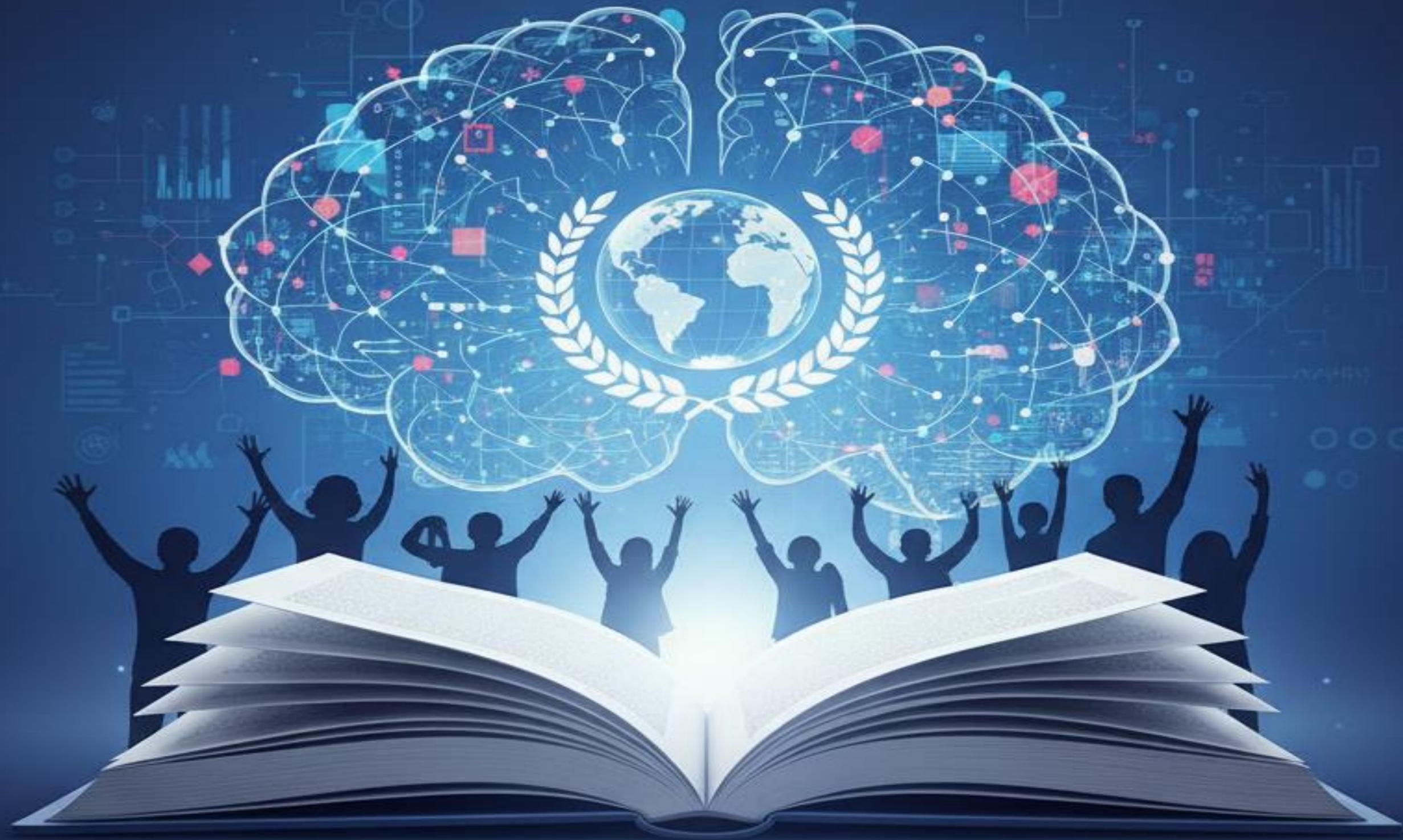

Intelligence Quotient

IQ is a Score derived from a Standardized Test Designed to Assess a Person's Cognitive Abilities or Intelligence.

Emotional Quotient

EQ refers to the Ability to Perceive, Understand, and Manage One's own Emotions, as well as the Emotions of Others.

Social Quotient

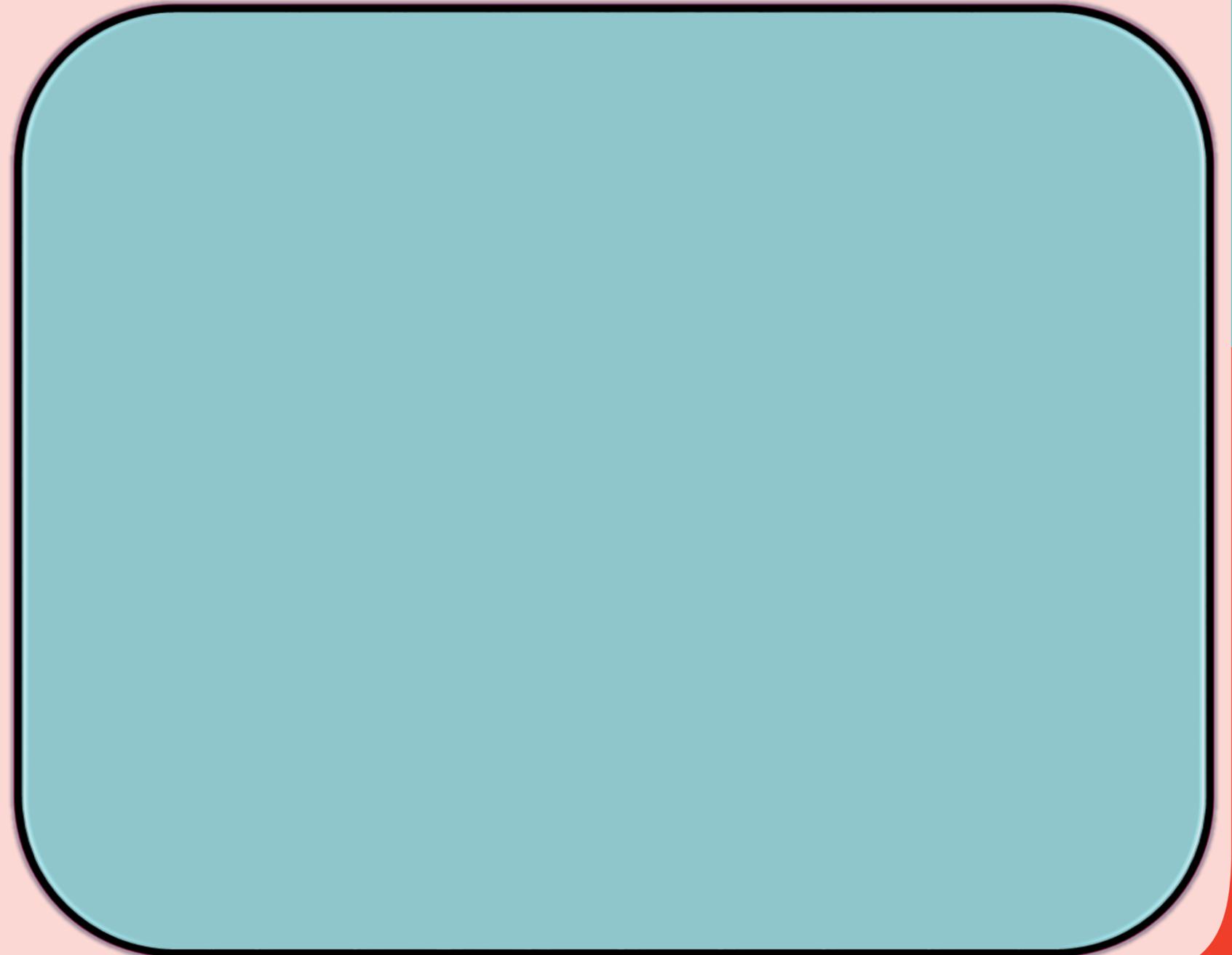

VARK Learning Concept



The VARK Learning Concept is a Model that Categories Individuals into Four Main Learning Styles: Visual, Auditory, Reading - Writing and Kinaesthetic. The theory suggests that while People use all Four Methods to Learn, they Typically have a Dominant or Preferred Style that allows them to Absorb and Retain Information Most Effectively. The VARK model is a Popular Concept because it Encourages both Students and Teachers to think about Learning in a more Dynamic Way, Moving Beyond a "One-Size-Fits-All" Approach.

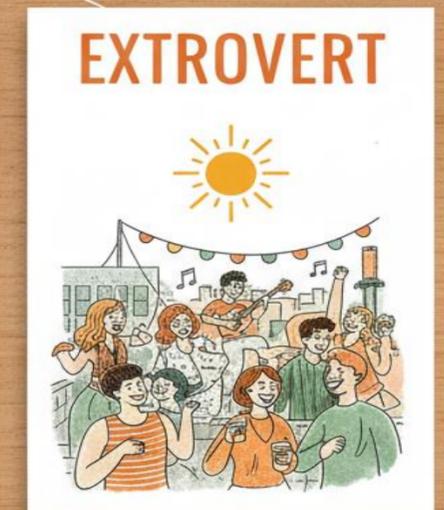
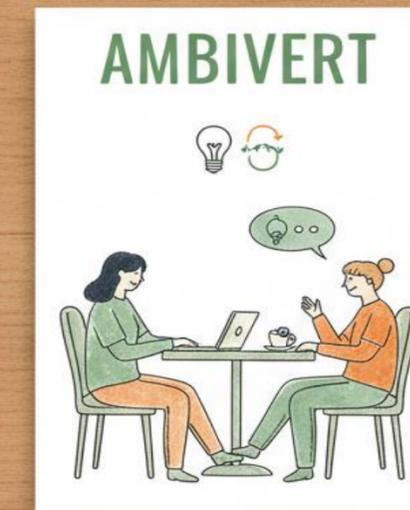
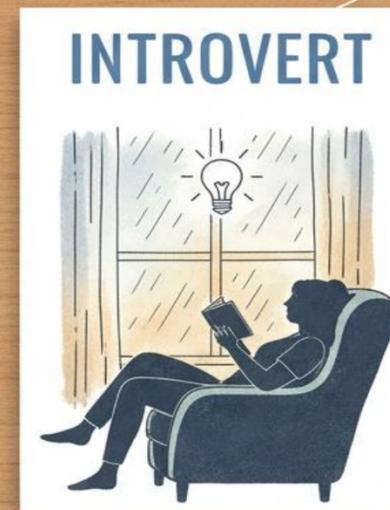
- ❖ **Introvert:** An **Introvert** is a Person who Gains Energy from Being alone or in Quiet, Low-Stimulation Environments. They Tend to Focus on their Inner Thoughts and Feelings. Introverts can be Social and Enjoy Spending Time with Others, but they Generally Prefer One-on-One Interactions or Small Groups Over Large Gatherings. After a Social Event, they Often Need Time alone to "Recharge" and Regain their Energy. Key Characteristics Include Being Reflective, Thoughtful, and a Good Listener.
- ❖ **Extrovert:** An **Extrovert** is a Person who Gains Energy from Social Interaction and External Stimulation. They are often Described as Outgoing, Sociable, and Talkative. Extroverts Thrive in Group Settings, Enjoy Meeting New People, and Feel Energised by Being Around Others. They Tend to Process their Thoughts by Talking them Through Out Loud. For an Extrovert, Spending too much Time alone can Feel Draining or Boring.
- ❖ **Ambivert:** An **Ambivert** is a Person who Exhibits a Balance of both Introverted and Extroverted Traits. They are the Most Common Personality Type. An Ambivert's Behaviour often Adapts to the Situation; they can be Comfortable and Energised in Social Settings but also Appreciate and Need alone Time to Recharge. They can Switch Between Being Outgoing and Reserved, often making them Excellent Communicators and Adaptable to Various Situations.
